He takes the stick and swipes the prize.

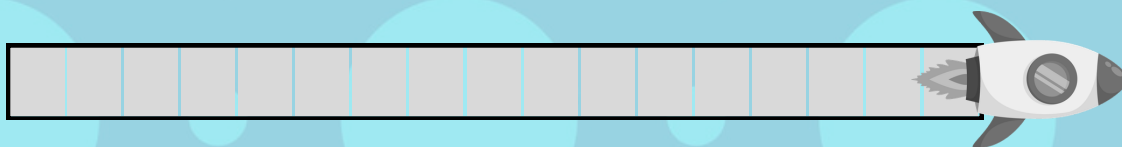
The bees do not like this. They chase Clive.

He gets to his den. Clive is safe with his prize.

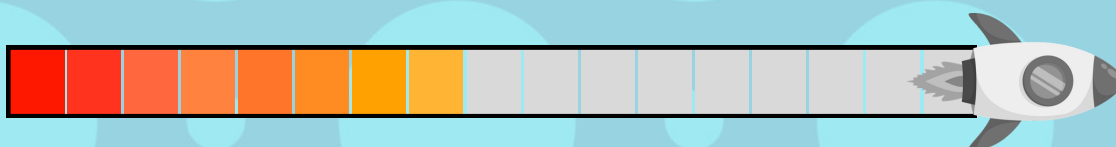

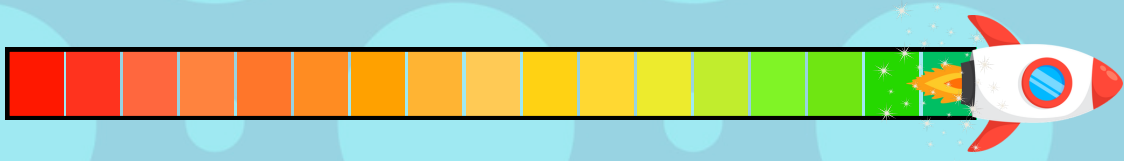
