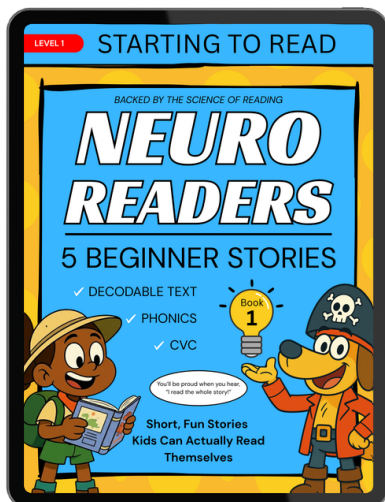

Run, Chick!

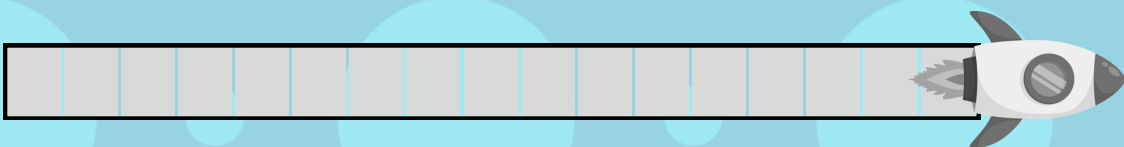


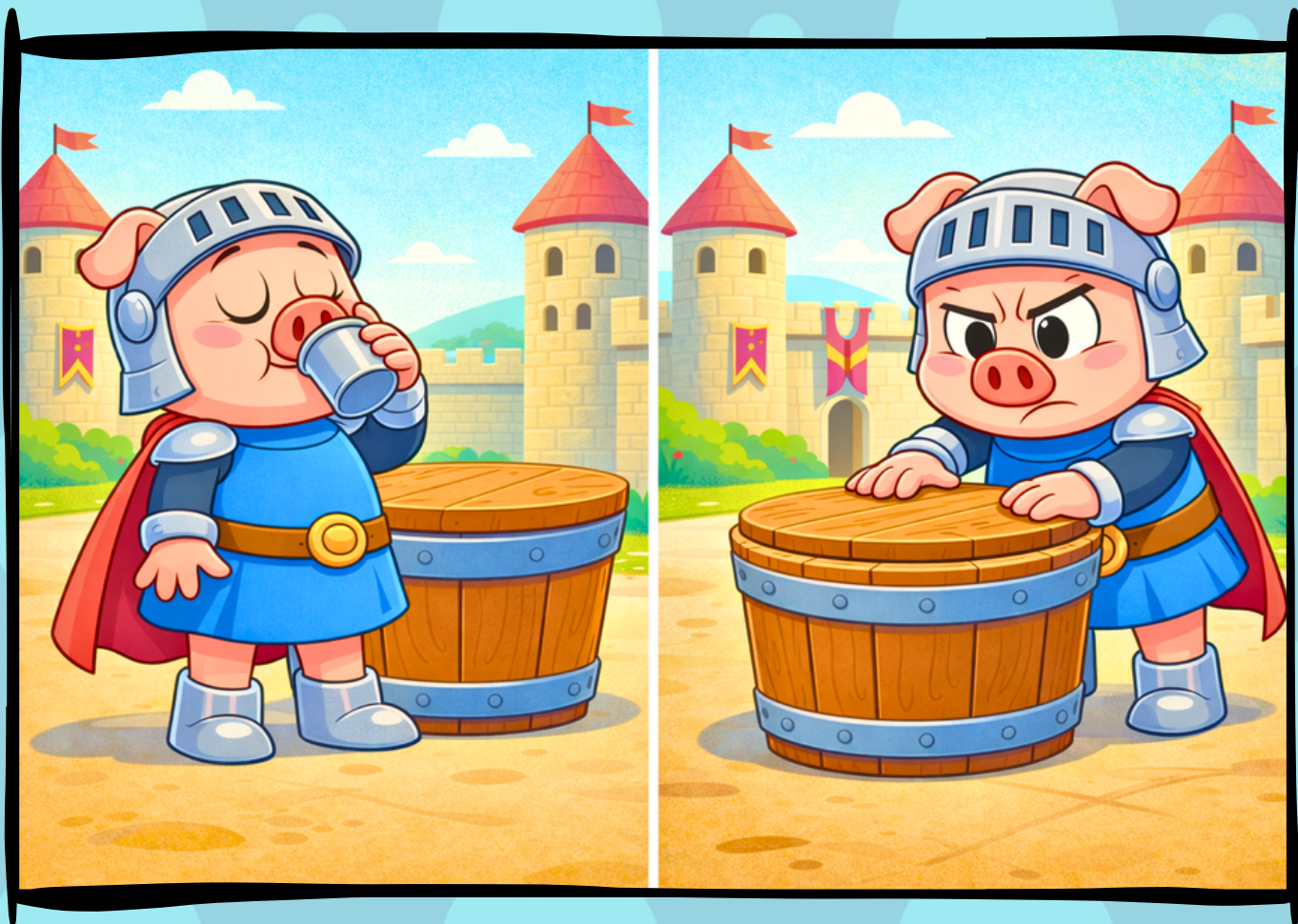

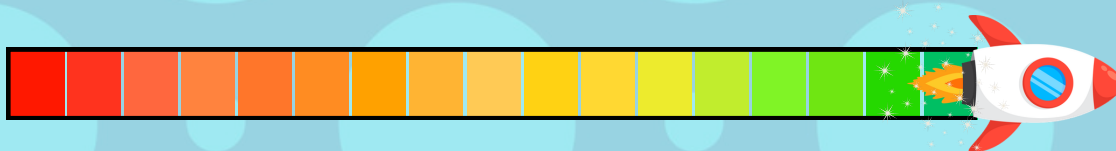


Chick did not sit still.
