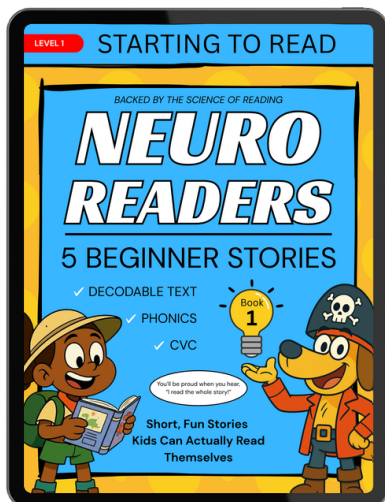

He is getting the bug.

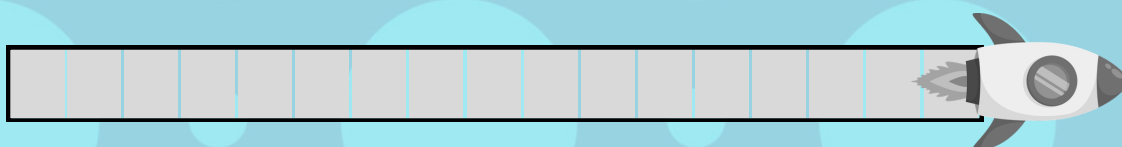
Then Mack is resting once more.

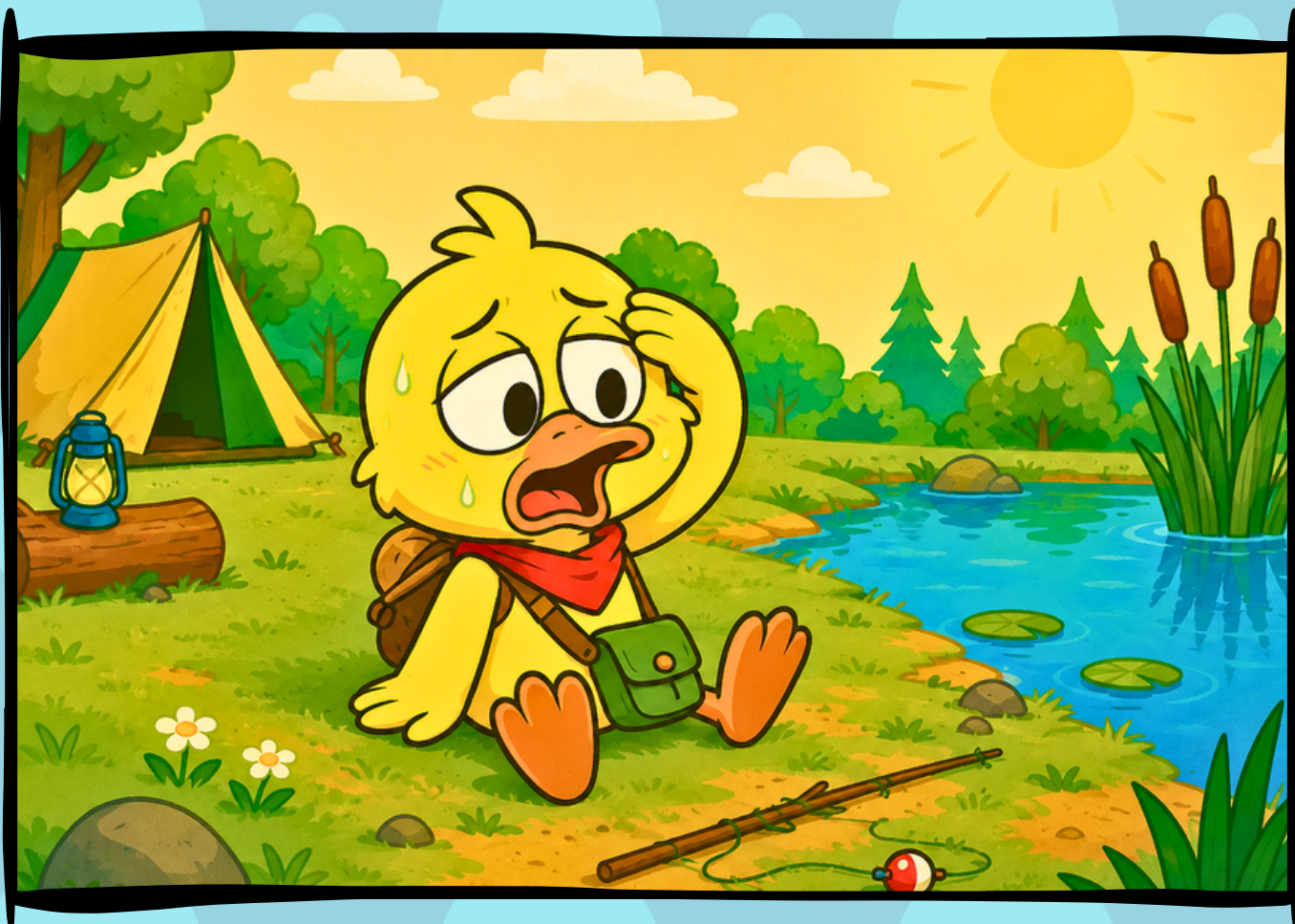


Mack is a duck.

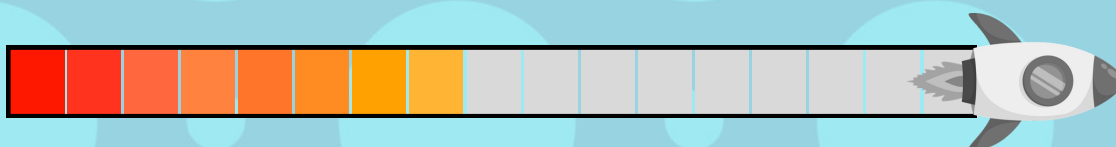
Mack is camping by the pond.

bugs.



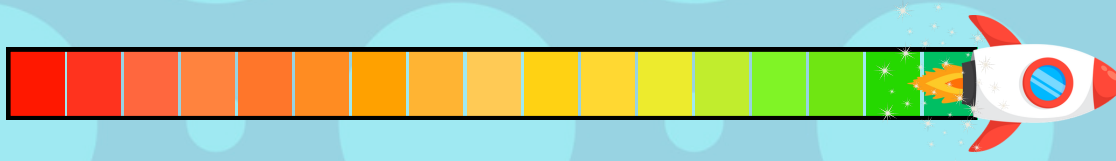


Mack is getting hot.
