He dropped a donut on a hill.

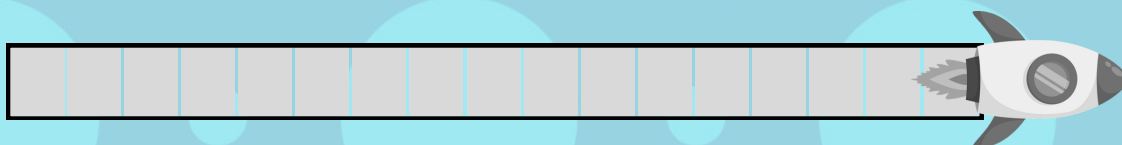

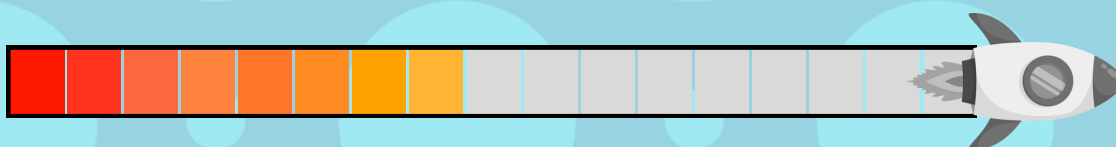

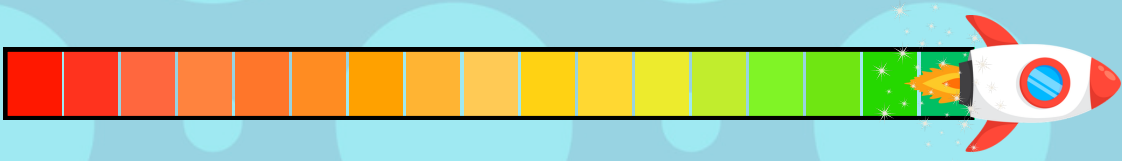
