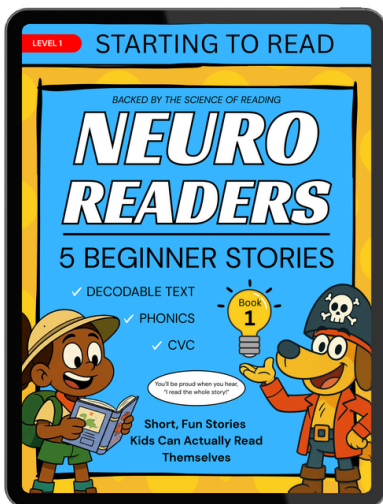

He fetched a long stick and snatched the ball.

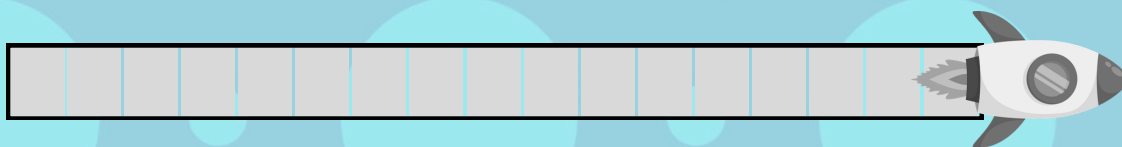
“Oh no!” said Stitch.

catch.

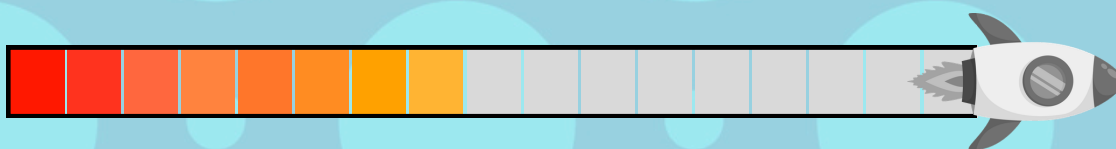


Stitch loves to play catch.

ball



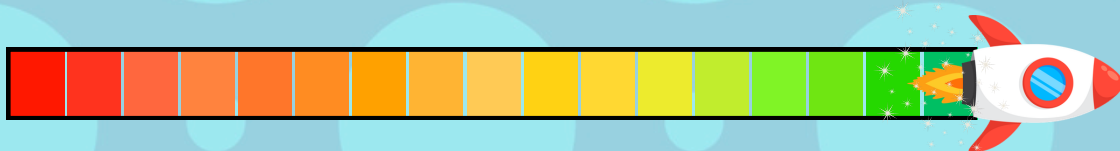


He fetched a long stick and
